



BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Riverside County Education Academy is a public school charter that operates as a separate public school district and has an independent Governing Board. The Board with, and oversees, the Executive Director who manages the day-to-day operations of the charter school programs. The role of the Board is to oversee independent policy making, provide leadership in reviewing and creating policy and procedures, oversee academic and financial programs, review of interim financial reports and adoption of a balance annual budget, and provide leadership and feedback to the Executive Director.
